

2024 Bylaw Changes Summary, December 24, 2024

The bylaw changes have been triggered to align with the PMI Single Membership Model across Canada.

Article V – Membership – Updated

Section 1. General Membership Provisions

From

- A. Membership in the PMI Lakeshore Ontario Chapter requires membership in PMI®. The PMI Lakeshore Ontario Chapter shall not accept as members any individuals who have not been accepted as PMI® members.

Membership in this organization is voluntary and shall be open to any eligible person who has attained the age of majority and who is interested in furthering the purposes of the organization. Membership shall be open to all eligible persons without regard to race, creed, color, age, sex, marital status, national origin, religion, or physical or mental disability.

To

- A. Membership in the PMI Lakeshore Ontario Chapter requires membership in PMI®. The PMI Lakeshore Ontario Chapter shall not accept as members any individuals who have not been accepted as PMI® members.

Membership in this organization shall be open to any eligible person interested in furthering the purposes of the organization. Membership shall be open to all eligible persons without regard to race, creed, color, age, sex, marital status, national origin, religion, or physical or mental disability.

From

- G. All PMI Lakeshore, Ontario Chapter members may vote. Individual members may hold elected office, Student members cannot hold elected office.

To

- G. All PMI Lakeshore Ontario Chapter members in good standing are eligible to vote on all matters presented to Chapter membership. In addition, all PMI Lakeshore Ontario Chapter members meeting the qualifications are eligible to run for and hold a PMI Lakeshore Ontario Chapter elected position.

Article IX – Lakeshore Ontario Chapter's Finance – Updated

From

Section 2. PMI LAKESHORE ONTARIO CHAPTER annual membership dues shall be set by the PMI LAKESHORE ONTARIO CHAPTER'S Board and communicated to PMI in accordance with policies and procedures established by PMI.

To

Section 2. PMI LAKESHORE ONTARIO CHAPTER annual membership dues will be agreed upon between PMI and the PMI LAKESHORE ONTARIO CHAPTER's Board of Directors and communicated in accordance with policies and procedures established by PMI.

Article XI – Inurement and Conflict of Interest – Deleted

Section 3.

A. The facts regarding the relationship or interest as they relate to the contract or transaction are disclosed to the Board of Directors prior to commencement of any such contract or transaction.

B. The board in good faith authorizes the contract or transaction by a majority vote of the Directors who do not have an interest in the transaction or contract.

C. The contract or transaction is fair to PMI Lakeshore Ontario Chapter and complies with the laws and regulations of the applicable jurisdiction in which PMI Lakeshore Ontario Chapter is incorporated or registered at the time the contract or transaction is authorized, approved or ratified by the Board of Directors.

D. The interested individual shall not attend any part of a meeting of the directors during which the contract or transaction is discussed, unless the transaction relates to their remuneration or an indemnity or insurance to which they are a party.
